1.) SET THE STAGE

Gather a group of people (it could be 2 or 20)
Collect their Demographic Information

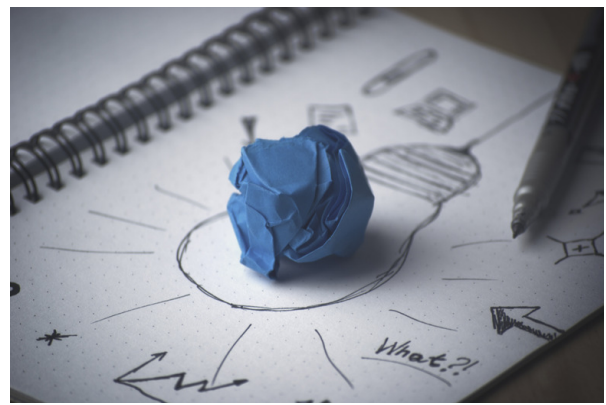
DISCUSSION PRINCIPLES:

- ✦ Whatever happens is the only thing that could have.

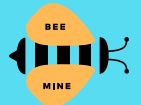
2.) GENERATE OR SELECT TOPIC(S) AROUND LEADERSHIP



Select topics that have come up during previous conversations on how to support leaders in our communities or choose your own area(s) for discussion on leadership development



3.) CAPTURE YOUR IDEAS

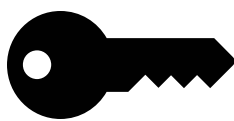


If your group has more than 6 people, set a timer for 6 minutes per topic. People can flutter in and out or pollinate ideas between groups.

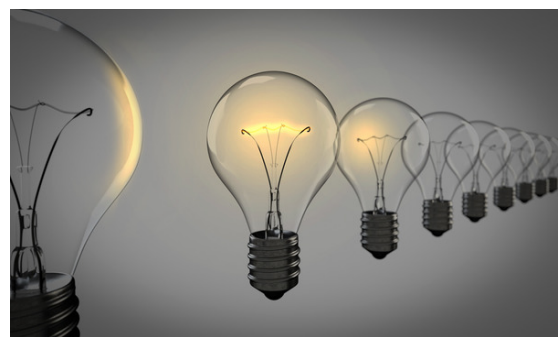


Use the included notes page to record the discussion from each group.

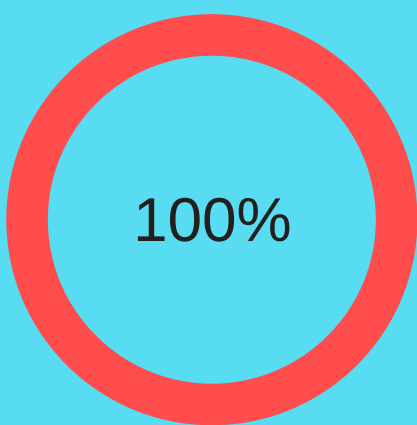
4.) SUMMARIZE AND RECOMMEND



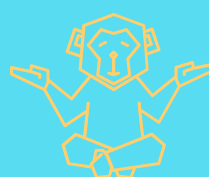
